### **Fox Forest, 309 Center Road, Hillsborough NH**

- *From the east/north: Rt. 202/9. Take the Henniker St./W. Main St. Hillsborough exit. Go left at stop sign at end of exit ramp. Go 1.8 miles to traffic light in the center of Hillsborough. Go right onto School Street (which becomes Center Road after the school). Fox Forest is approximately 2 miles on the right.*
- *From the west/south: Rt. 9. Take the Hillsborough/Peterborough exit. Go right at stop sign at end of exit ramp. Go left at traffic light (by McDonald's). Go 1.4 miles to traffic light in the center of Hillsborough. Go left onto School Street (which becomes Center Road after the school). Fox Forest is approximately 2 miles on the right.*

Sometimes GPS sends folks down an impassible Class 6 road!
